\* I spent all day Monday and Tuesday following leads related to Richard Case Nagell's death, autopsy, the executor of his estate and related matters. I spent portions of Wedneday afternoon and Thurday conducting additional telephone interviews.

\* I spent Wednesday morning at Archives II concluding my review of Warren Commission Exhibits and Documents relative to Gum Shoe issues 15, 16, 17, 18, 24 and 25.

\* FINCEN sent a number of responses on Monday relative to Issue 23. I spent Wednesday afternoon and Thursday analyzing that information and entering it in the Public Contacts database.

## Dave

\* Dave spent a good portion of this week trying to get to the bottom of the Charles Bronson/John Sigalos story. He determined that Mr. Bronson died on June 30, 1995 and obtained a copy of the death certificate. He spoke with Mrs. Bronson and two of her sons-in-law.
