Ms. Williams and I discussed the records retention policy of former sheriffs; she told me she doubted your office had any records relating to the voter registration drives of the summer of 1963. As you may recall, the House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA) spent time during its tenure in the late 1970's investigating the possibility that Lee Harvey Oswald was present in the Clinton/Jackson area during a Congress of Racial Equality (CORE) voter registration drive in 1963. Because it is the Review Board's responsibility to locate any records the HSCA used or referred to I wanted to meet with a member of your staff on my upcoming trip to Louisiana. Ms. Williams and I made an appointment to meet at your office on Wednesday October 4, 1995 at 8:15 am. I hope you will be able to join us for that meeting.

My thanks in advance to you and Ms. Williams for your cooperation and time with this matter. I look forward to meeting both of you on October 4.
