Subject: Recommendation of Not Believed Relevant (NBR) Status for Record

This record is comprised of a routing slip, a newspaper clipping and a memo. The article from the New York Times, 11 May 1971, describes three individuals who were about to visit China. In the current review, as in the 1993 review, the CIA releases the routing slip and the article and requests postponement in full of the memo.

Considering the time frame and the subject, the Review Board staff recommends that all of the information in the memo about the individuals be postponed as NBR, but recommends that, in addition to the routing sheet and the newspaper clipping, the date, the subject and the source be released on the first page of the memo.

For substitute language the Review Board staff recommends: "Information relating to individuals not believed relevant to the assassination of President Kennedy."
