Regarding the appearance of the names Win Scott, Thomas C. Mann, Marty Underwood, and Walter Sheridan in databases at the Library of Congress: None of these names appear in any “author” databases, indicating that they have not written anything that is in the Library of Congress collection. None of the names appear in the “subject” database, with the exception of Thomas Mann’s confirmation hearings from 1965.

Background information may possibly be gleaned from secondary sources on Latin America, Mexico, or the CIA; a preliminary search of the books the Library has provided to this point reveals nothing. (It should be noted that the Library has, to this point, found only two of the six books I have requested.)

Upon receipt of the remaining books, I will continue looking in them for pertinent information. At this time, the Library is still “retrieving” my requested books. After the CIA briefing tomorrow, if time permits, I will continue to follow up on this project.
