Over the course of the work of the Assassination Records Review Board, we have compiled a large amount of audio-visual items for the JFK collection. There are numerous audio tapes of interviews, videos and motion picture films from the day of the assassination, and other relevant items. In order to provide an accurate and convenient finding aid for these items, we need to create a database that will make it easy for a researcher to determine exactly what material we have and what use they might find for it.

You will be given each of the items we have collected by Dave Montague, our Senior Investigator and the person responsible for the acquisition of most of these items. When you get plugged in to the database, it will look like the attached pages.
