This past summer, I had the opportunity to supervise Courtney in a short-term internship at the Assassination Records Review Board. I found her to be inquisitive and self-motivated, so I assigned her a project that reflected the qualities I believed I saw in her. Courtney fulfilled every expectation I had, and more. She politely declined, telling me that she wanted to finish what she had started, and continued to work, missing the presentation but completing the project with the same diligence she had showed throughout. I must say that I was highly impressed with that display of dedication and discipline. I have every confidence that she will bring that same strength and dedication to her studies, and that she will excel above and beyond her peers. I fully expect that she will be a valued contributor to your institution's community.
