Dear Mr. Hoch,

As the Board anticipates its work coming to a close, we have been evaluating the materials we ought to be reviewing in the amount of time we have left. Your many letters to us have been invaluable in this evaluation. We thank you once again for your input and ideas.

As we have reviewed your letters, we have realized that we have not, in all cases, responded specifically to some of your requests or ideas. This letter is an attempt to address some of the issues you have brought up with us in the past.

If there is an area of concern to you that we have not yet addressed, please keep in mind that our work is still in progress.

In a letter dated November 28, 1994, you requested that we attempt to obtain records of the Dallas Police Department. In response to requests made in November 1996, we were informed by Lois Dillard, Records Management Officer for Dallas County, that all non-elected Dallas County were ordered by County statute to turn over all their records pertaining to the assassination to the Dallas County Historical Foundation, which operates the Sixth Floor Museum. As these records are already available to the public, the Review Board will not be pursuing them for review. A copy of Ms. Dillard's response is enclosed for your information.
