RE: Sen. Moynihan's Papers at Library of Congress

Following our discussion yesterday, I went to the Library of Congress and looked through the two folders among Daniel P. Moynihan's papers that are related to the assassination of President Kennedy. Many of the papers in these folders are newspaper and magazine articles relating to media coverage of the assassination, the Warren Commission, and the trial of Jack Ruby.

Moynihan's documents held at the Library of Congress include a transcript of a television interview Moynihan gave to WTOP in Washington within a few days after the assassination. Also included are letters between Moynihan and individuals who wrote to praise him for his eloquence during the interview.

Also among Moynihan's papers is an account of how he learned of the assassination. After hearing the news, Moynihan and his colleagues rushed to the White House. His account also includes his observations of the reactions of people at the White House.
