Guide to Postponement Computer Analysis

1a - Does the record reveal an intelligence agent whose identity currently requires protection?

1a.1: Does the record reveal an intelligence agent whose identity currently requires protection?

- No evidence that identity currently requires protection.

- Cannot determine.

1a.2: Would disclosure threaten (i)national defense; (ii)intelligence operations; (iii) foreign relations of the United States?

- No evidence that disclosure would threaten.
- Evidence that disclosure would threaten.
- Cannot determine whether disclosure would threaten.

1a.3: Does the threat to national security outweigh the public interest?

- The threat does not outweigh public interest.
- The threat outweighs public interest.
- Cannot Determine.

1b - Does the record disclose a source or method that is or could be utilized by the U.S. Government and has not been officially disclosed and disclosure would interfere with the conduct of intelligence activities?

1b.1: Record discloses a source or method that is or could be utilized by the U.S. Government
