Dear Dr. Humes:

I am writing to thank you for appearing as requested for deposition on February 13, 1996. We appreciate your willingness to reschedule to the February 13th date, and I want to thank you for the documents you produced in response to the request in the subpoena. The travel claim you signed has been submitted, and your reimbursement check for travel expenses and per diem will be mailed to you as soon as your claim is processed.

I am returning with this letter the videotape you loaned to us (which has been copied), and all of the original copies of documents you brought to the deposition, with two exceptions: namely, the onionskin copies (with signatures and/or marginalia in original ink) of the November, 1966 Inventory of Autopsy Photographs and X-Rays, and the January, 1967 so-called Military Review Report which relates the autopsy photos and X-Rays to the autopsy protocol results from November, 1963. Because these documents contain original notations and signatures, it is our preference to donate these to the JFK Collection at the National Archives, rather than photocopies. Nevertheless, if this arrangement is not acceptable to you, please notify us and we will return those two documents to you.

Thank you again for your cooperation with the Review Board's ongoing attempt to identify, locate, gather and clarify records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.
