Vladimir Slovoda

- 1. The Military Team has now completed review of the extensive Army counterintelligence file on Vladimir Slovoda. At the August 6, 1998 Board Meeting, the Review Board approved a Military Team recommendation to designate four individual records within the Slovoda file as "Not Believed Relevant."
- 2. Appended to this memo is an e-mail from Military Team member Mosemarie Boyd that identifies 15 additional records from within the voluminous Slovoda file that appear irrelevant to the Kennedy assassination; furthermore, they do not mention the name of either Slovoda himself or any of his family members or work associates.
- 3. The Slovoda file is one of the 34 IRR case files studied by the HSCA, and consequently all records within it were automatically RIFed by the Army prior to review by the ARRB staff. It consists of hundreds of RIFed documents, of which these 15 in question represent less than 5 per cent.
- 4. The staff recommendation is to declare these 15 records as "NBR."
