Subject:Preliminary Review of "Attachment #2" from the Medical RecordPetition

At your request I recently reviewed the second attachment to the petition submitted by Aguilar, Crenshaw, Cunningham, et al. Attachment # 2 consists of "RIF" information from 46 documents that, according to the petitioners, are currently held by the Archives in a "referred" status. Most of the documents are from the HSCA collection. The petitioners request that Board "obtain and make available in full all of the records listed."

Of the 46 documents requested, six are duplicates or triplicates of other requests. Four documents are requested twice, one document is requested three different times.

Nine of the requested referred documents are actually open in full according to our database. Several others are listed as referred, but I suspect they have been previously released by the originating agencies. Some of the documents, at least from the RIF information, do not appear to have any connection to medical/autopsy evidence.¹

So far, I have retrieved about ten of the requested documents. I will get the rest at Archives I next week and make a full report soon thereafter.

¹ For example, request # 18 identifies a document with Agency File No. 009881, but with no other information. The petitioners note that this document "involves Katzenbach and Hoover and the medical evidence." I found 15 documents with this file number in our databases, 14 are open in full. Most deal with Katzenbach and/or Hoover, but none of them make any mention of medical records.
