I serve as a member of an international panel of experts assembled by the German Historical Museum to advise them on the creation of a museum in Berlin to commemorate the presence of the Western Allies (*Expertenkommission des allierten Museums*). I was nominated to serve on this panel by the US Army Command in Berlin as one of the three individuals (since increased to five) in the American delegation. The French, British, and Germans have similarly constituted delegations. My service is unpaid. The Board was aware of my service on this panel at the time I was hired and has approved my continued association.

The Museum receives much of its funding from the German government, but is an independent (non-profit) corporate entity.

Our next regular commission meeting is scheduled for March 11 and 12 in Berlin, and I plan to attend. The purpose of this memo is to seek guidance on my ability to accept reimbursement for my travel costs.
