

Notice of Public Hearing

The Assassination Records Review Board will hold a Public Hearing at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, October 11, 1994 in the National Archives and Records Administration Auditorium (5th Floor), 7th and Pennsylvania Avenue, Washington, DC. The purpose of the hearing is to elicit public comment to assist the Board in establishing a definition of an "assassination record" in connection with the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992 (Pub. L. 102-526).
