Tracy:

I am faxing a copy of the correspondence I had with Leslie Atkinson last year. As you can see, we requested that Congressman Stokes send a letter to a former HSCA staffer indicating that contact with the Assassination Records Review Board (ARRB) would not violate the terms of the nondisclosure form that the HSCA staff was required to sign. Mr. Stokes did send the requested letter, and the ARRB did received the requested information from the former staffer.

We find ourselves in a similar situation today. We have organized a meeting of former HSCA staffers who, we hope, will assist us in our search for additional records relating to the assassination of President Kennedy. One of the staffers voiced some concern about his ability to speak openly with us because of the nondisclosure form that he had signed. It would be most helpful if Congressman Stokes could send a letter similar to that which he sent last year to each of the former staffers with whom we are meeting. I am sending a proposed text along with a list of the names and addresses of the former staffers.

Since the meeting is scheduled to take place on Monday October 28, 1996, there is some urgency attached to this request. Please let me know as soon as possible if this all can be arranged. We would appreciate being cc'd on any letter that is sent.
