Dear John:

Pursuant to its authority under the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, the Assassination Records Review Board requests that you provide descriptive information regarding the "Interagency Source Register" cited in the attached document.

Please explain the function of the Interagency Source Register. We believe that this "Register" might be of assistance in enabling us to identify personnel who appear in the documents we are reviewing. It would be helpful to us to learn when this "Register" began functioning, and for what purpose it was used and which entity or entities in the intelligence community maintained it. With regard to learning who are the actual individuals listed in the "Register" we would be interested in the period beginning in 1958 and ending in 1965. If this "Register" was discontinued during the 1958-1965 period, we would like to know why and what type of records maintenance system replaced it.

This request should be interpreted in its broadest reasonable sense. To the extent that you are not certain whether certain information comes under the scope of this request, please let us know and we can advise you whether we seek to include it.

Should this request impose an unreasonable burden on you that we may have not anticipated, please advise us so that we can work with you to modify or amend the request accordingly.
