The attached memos that were prepared for the Rockefeller Commission on papers from DCI McCone deal with Cuban policy and actions taken after the assassination of President Kennedy.

On page 7 of the 4/22/75 memo to the files from Mason Cargill, he discusses three memos written in the period from 11/23/63 to 12/31/63. A 11/25/63 memo discusses what McCone told LBJ of information received from Mexico City regarding "...the holding of a Mexican employee of the Cuban embassy by Mexican officials for interrogation concerning Lee Oswald." An 11/26 memo discusses LBJ's instructions to DCI McCone to "insure" the CIA's cooperation with the FBI report on the assassination. Also, in an 11/29/63 meeting with LBJ, McNamara and Bundy, McCone "apparently" gave them the latest developments in the Mexico City investigation of Oswald.
