The attached is a redacted document of a Special Group Meeting of 8/25/60. The beginning deals with the Congo and there is a considerable portion on Cuba that is unredacted. However, it is not known what is in blanked out part of the memo.

The individuals present at the meeting were Messrs. Merchant, Gray, Irwin and Dulles. Thomas Parrott wrote a memorandum for the record.

DCI Dulles talked about the progress made in establishing contact with certain dissident groups inside Cuba. According to Parrott, he mentioned "the apparent fulfillment of a sabotage requirement which had been levied on one of these groups as a test of its capabilities (after this action had been cleared with the Special Group)."

The development of a paramilitary force is discussed and there was also a discussion of anti-Castro groups such as the Frente.
