This file begins with a memo from the Chief of the Freedom of Information/Privacy Act Unit in the Criminal Division of the Justice Department to a staffer on the Senate Intelligence Committee. It says that we (DoJ) have reviewed the 5 Congressional documents which contain Criminal Division information and have made recommendations for the five documents. However, the one page memo does not identify the documents.

The text which follows this one page memorandum consists of questioning by Church Committee staffers of Walter Sheridan on 9/19/75. There are many redactions in the document. The focus of the inquiry with Sheridan is the period from the beginning of the Kennedy Administration up to March or April, 1962. Sheridan was a Special Consultant to the Attorney General.

The testimony appears to focus on organized crime matters. On page 17, there is a discussion of the Garrison investigation that Sheridan was part of while with NBC. Page 18 is not in the document at NARA but unlike other pages there is no redaction - it just is not there. That page is needed if one is to discover Sheridan's reaction to the Garrison investigation.
