NSA Questions:

In connection with the Boards interest in the pursuit of information surrounding the JFK Assassination the following documentation is requested:

- National Security Agency files on: Any and all cables, records, files, reports, photographs, and regulations pertaining to the Department of Defense advance work, coordination and actual protection of the President and the Vice President in the connect of public appearances and travel in 1963.

- National Security Agency personnel present in Dallas on the day of the assassination, their duties and functions.

- National Security Agency personnel assigned to the 112th Intelligence Group and the SIGINT capabilities of the Group at the time of the assassination.

- All information concerning the Embassies/Consulates are on Signal Intelligence targets: Reports and analysis that resulted from

that collection.

- *Moscow Embassy (DC) from the fall of 1959 through 1964/Consulates throughout the United States*
- *American Embassy Mexico City the Summer of 1963 through Dec 64. Reports on support to Chief of Station (COS). Names of attaché personnel assigned.*

Data relating to the Cuban Intelligence networks of Castro covering the period from 1959 -December 31 1964 with emphasis on operations by Cuban Intelligence operatives in the United States and other Latin American countries, and any analyses of the direction and evaluation of specific assassination operations.

- Papers of Richard Mosk NSA liaison to the Warren Commission (WC). NSA correspondence between the Warren Commission and the HSCA.

- Specifically a July 1964 Memo from Mr. Mosk to the WC

- Correspondence between Mosk and Howard P. Willens of the WC

- Correspondence between Dr. Tordella NSA Director of Operations the FBI, CIA and the Warren
