Why was Oswald given such quality treatment in the Soviet Union?

Who were the other expatriates in the Soviet Union who assocated with Oswald?

How were defectors/desertors normally treated when and if they returned to the

United States?

What was the State Departments role in monitoring Oswald's defection?

What happen to the Garrison investigative files?

What was the explanation from the Defense Department on Oswald's language testing?

Did the Marines keep a separate file on Oswald language capabilities?

Does Ms. McMillian feel that the Russians have more information to offer on the

Oswald defection? If so who would have it? and how can we get it? When will the board brief the Secretary of Defense on the need for documents conerning the assassination? For the board

IT is well documented that the Department of Defense has not cooperated with either the Warren Commission or the House Select Committee? The staff has evidence that DoD is still not turning over documents to the archives in support of the statute.
