The President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992 (“JFK Act”) requires each Government office to “review, identify and organize each assassination record in its *custody or possession* for disclosure to the public, review by the Review Board, and transmission to the Archivist.” 44 U.S.C.
