Intercepted Telephone Calls between Cuban and Soviet Embassies in Mexico City

- 27 SEP 63 Silvia Duran at Cuban Embassy calls Soviet Embassy
"American citizen requesting a transit visa."
- 27 SEP 63 Unid. Man at Soviet Embassy calls Silvia Duran
"Visa application for the American."
- 28 SEP 63 Silvia Duran calls Soviet Embassy and puts American on the line.
- 1 OCT 63 Man calls Soviet Embassy and says "this is Oswald speaking."
Transcriber says Oswald is the one talking in both cases and the one who called
from Cuban Emb 28 Sept to Soviet Embassy.

26 NOV 63 MEXI 7068 President Dorticos calls Amb. Hernandez Armas of Cuban Embassy in Mexico City asks about Silvia Duran being picked up by Mexican police, Dorticos asks several times about money and asks Hernandez to question Silvia more, investigate more and call him.

27 NOV 63 MEXI 7104 Amb Mann reports conversation between Dorticos and Hernandez and confession of Gilberto Alvarado Ugarte

28 NOV 63 DIR 85616 HQ Reaction to Alvarado's story. Believe he fabricated his story. "We find it incredible that the Cubans would brief and pay an assassin in from of a Nicaraguan interloper."
