

Supplemental Statement to Standard Form 50-B

The Assassination Records Review Board is an independent federal agency created to oversee the identification and release of records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. The Review Board was established by the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992 (PL 102-526). The Board has until September 30, 1998 to fulfill its mandate. Due to the temporary status of the agency, the Review Board does not have the practice of completing performance appraisals for its employees.
