Thank you for visiting our offices today for the purpose of reviewing House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA) records referred to the IRS by the National Archives and Record Administration (NARA) under the JFK Act. We very much appreciate your cooperation.

I am writing to confirm that, after reviewing HSCA records 180-10097-10239 and 180-10075-10180, you indicated that the IRS has no objection to their release.

An additional HSCA record, 180-10095-10073, raises issues you wish to review further. You indicated you would let us know the results of your review upon its completion.

Our Board would like to make a determination regarding this document at its meeting of April 16-17, 1996. Should the IRS have any objections to the release of any part of the record, the agency should inform the Board of its objections - with specificity -- by April 9, 1996. Our Board will consider any evidence the IRS wishes to submit in support of such objections.
