The record listed above is contained within the *Donor Restricted Material From NLJ 1* record series of the JFK Collection. Its current status as referenced on its attached Record Information Form (RIF) is "referred."

This record is a seven-page memorandum, dated February 27, 1967, from Andrew Sciambra to New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison. It is open in full elsewhere in the JFK Collection. In fact, the memorandum was read verbatim into the record of the Clay Shaw trial on February 10, 1969. The trial transcript is open in the House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA) portion of the JFK Collection (HSCA Record Number 180-10097-10190, pp. 84-108). A photocopy of this portion of the trial transcript is attached for your review.

Given that the document in question has been in the public realm for over a quarter century, it is our Board's intention to open NARA Record Number 179-3003-10262 at its meeting of June 4-5. Should you have any questions or objections, please contact us by May 28, 1996.
