Issue 1 - Transfer of HSCA documents to ARRB for purposes of review.

As the ARRB begins to undertake its review function in earnest, there is an obvious need to have HSCA documents physically present at the ARRB for staff reveiw and Board consideration. The facilities at Archives I are too small, and Archives staffing constraints too restrictive, to allow for the study and review of HSCA documents at that facility -- this is especially true given the Board's limited life-span and the consequent need to process and review documents efficiently and expeditiously. The House Oversight Committee can feel confident, however, that HSCA documents will be secure at the ARRB: our office is a Security Classified Information Facility (SCIF), and all ARRB staff having access to classified HSCA documents have Top Secret clearances.

Issue 2 - Representation before the ARRB on recommended postponements of HSCA documents.

As the Board undertakes its review of HSCA documents that have been recommended for postponement, the issue arises as to who will argue the merits of these recommendations to the Board -- the Center for Legislative Archives, House Oversight Committee Staff, etc.

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
