In accordance with the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, I am writing to inform you that the Assassinations Records Review Board, at its meeting of June 5, 1996, made formal determinations concerning the above House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA) record.

It has come to our attention that you may not have received written notification of this action, and so I wanted to make certain you were fully apprised of the Board's decisions. Enclosed you will find a list of the determinations the Review Board made relative to this record. These decisions were premised on several factors, including the historical interest in the documents and the absence of evidence that the release of the information would cause harm to the United States or to any individual.

You have seven days to appeal these decisions to the President. You are invited to send your representative to the Review Board to examine our copies of the documents for which determinations have been made and to discuss the determinations with my staff.
