Subject: Conversation with Steve Tilley, re: Church and Pike Committee Records

Steve says there are 3 boxes of Pike Committee records at Archives II which were processed by HPSCI staffers. Steve recalls the staffers involved as Mike Sheehy and Sharon Cursio (sp).

There are 40 boxes of Church Committee materials. These materials were generated by staff from the Senate Intelligence Committee (led by Joe Battaglia and Judy Hodgson, formerly Minority staffers but now Staff Director and Assistant to Staff Director, respectively) who implemented the JFK Act relative to Church Committee records. The documents out at Archives II are redacted, and the unredacted copies are in the possession of Senate Intelligence Committee. NARA does not yet have the disks for these records, as the Committee supposedly has one box yet to complete. In addition, Steve believes there is a whole subset of Church Committee records that the Intelligence Committee staffers may not have processed yet -- for instance there are 44 individuals referenced in footnotes to Volume 5 of the Church report as having testified whose testimony is not included in the 40 boxes NARA has received to date. Steve has sent a letter to the Senate Intelligence Committee on this problem and spoke with someone much earlier this year (May or so) but has heard nothing from them about how it will be resolved.

HPSCI/Pike Committee records are presently part of our Open/Referred/Postponed databases. The Church Committee stuff is not in our databases, but Steve has a finding aid for the 40 boxes out at NARA II.
