247RFK sent info on "hundreds of racketeers" sent to NSA and asked it for comments and information.

248In 1962 NSA is intercepting communications between US and Cuba and is keeping information on contacts. FBI gives NSA information on persons travelling between US and Cuba.

248NSA director in 1962: Marshall Carter

248NSA begins domestic surveillance in 1962--escalates starting 1967.

250"NSA's vacuum cleaner approach to intelligence collection -- whereby it sucks into its system the maximum amount of telecommunications and then filters it through an enormous screen of 'trigger words'" Analysts end up reviewing telephone calls.

250Office of Production (PROD)  
[as of circa 1967], PROD G Group responsible for processing SIGINT from all non-Communist areas of the world, including US

G2 = Army Intelligence

252NSA did not inform HSCA that it had been involved in search for James Earl Ray.
