Dear Mr. Dix:

Thank you for your letter of February, 1995, that discussed several matters related to George Bush. I am sorry it has taken so long to respond, but we have, in the interim, pursued inquiries related to your concern.

We are very much aware of a November 29, 1963 FBI LHM that references a "Mr. George Bush of the Central Intelligence Agency" as having received an oral briefing about the Kennedy assassination. (copy enclosed) We are taking steps to pursue information related to that LHM.

In your letter, however, you characterize the issues in a way that goes far beyond the documentary evidence of which we are now aware. For example, you report that "two weeks after the assassination FBI Chief J. Edgar Hoover gave a private top secret briefing to 'CIA Special Agent, George Bush.'" We are unaware that Mr. Hoover gave any briefing to George Bush, or of any document that employs such language, just as we also are unaware of any CIA record that refers to anyone as a "CIA Special Agent." We also are aware of specific evidence supporting similar allegations. If you have any documentary evidence supporting these important allegations, we would be very interested in hearing from you so that we can follow-up on them.

As you know, the Review Board is not seeking to reach any conclusions regarding the assassination, but is primarily concerned with identifying, clarifying, locating, and making available assassination records. We appreciate your help in possibly locating additional assassination records to clarify the historical record.
