

Dear Mr. Manchester:

I would like to thank you again for taking the time to meet with representatives of the Review Board last Monday. It was a pleasure and an honor to meet with you and to discuss issues related to your book *Death of a President*.

As we promised, I am enclosing copies of your notes for *DOAP* that you provided to investigators for the House Select Committee on Assassinations. It is our understanding that you provided them access to your materials and permitted them to identify those records that were of particular interest to them. We understand that you then asked your secretary to make copies of the records and forwarded them to the HSCA along with an invoice for the copies and for your secretary's time. The records that I am enclosing are the copies that we have thus far been able to locate from the HSCA records. We are also forwarding a copy of these records to your attorney, Mr. Lynch, and to the JFK Library in Boston.

Once again, we sincerely hope that we will be able to work out a procedure that will both satisfy your concerns and serve the larger interests of history.
