Please return your written suggestions to me by Tuesday, June 2, at 12:00 noon so that we can collate your responses and fax a working draft of points back to you by June 3.

What are the most important lessons that have been learned?

Was it worth doing?

Could it have been done without having an independent agency oversee the process?

What were the biggest obstacles?

How could the JFK Act have worked better?

What powers should the Board have had that it did not have?

How effective are government policies on classification?

How effective are government policies on declassification?

How aware are agencies about what information is and is not in the public domain?

How cooperative were agencies with the Review Board?

Should there be new legislation or changes in the laws?
