I told her that I myself was uncertain of the facts, but that I understand that we have one original film (of outtakes) in the office. I told her that we intend to send the original to the Archives. The Archives presumably will make copies available to the public, but that such questions are more appropriate for the Archives. She said that Eileen told her that we were preparing a Deed of Gift. I confirmed that.
