

**Assassination Records Review Board
Notation Voting Form
Guidelines for Processing and Reviewing
Segregated Records and "NBRs"
November 13, 1996**

This notation voting form is being distributed to each Member of the Assassination Records Review Board. The Members of the Board are requested to vote on and sign this form. In accordance with the terms of the Sunshine Act, the Members of the Board must not, while in a group of three or more Members, "deliberate" on the advisability of adopting the proposed Guidelines.

The Review Board conducted hearings and held an open meeting in Washington, D.C. on the issue of the review of segregated records and the appropriateness of designating records and files as "NBRs." In accordance with the Board's instructions at the October 30, 1996 meeting, the staff has prepared the attached "Guidelines for Processing and Reviewing Records in the Segregated Collections and Records that Contain Information with No Believed Relevance ("NBR") to the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy."

If the Guidelines are adopted, the Review Board may subsequently amend them after a discussion and vote at a properly noticed meeting.

The staff recommends that the Review Board vote to adopt the attached Guidelines.
