PRIVACY ACT NOTICE FOR REVIEW BOARD EMPLOYEES

In order to adjudicate SCI clearances, CIA must have access to personnel security files and background investigation information currently in the possession of the Review Board. Obtaining an SCI clearance is a requirement for continued employment as a staff member of the Review Board.

The undersigned individual acknowledges that he or she has been informed of, and consents to, the Review Board's disclosure of information to, and entering into consultations with, the CIA in relationship to the obtaining of SCI clearances.

The CIA and the Review Board must comply with all applicable federal statutes and regulations regarding the privacy of such files.
