

Mrs. Nancy Sheridan

All papers, records, documents, etc. in your possession, custody, or control that:

1. relate to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy,
2. relate to any investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy (or to Jack Ruby or to Sam Giancana) that was conducted at any time between November 22, 1963 and February 28, 1964,
3. that were in the possession or custody of, or on deposit with, the John F. Kennedy Library at any time but which were returned to you or your agent after the enactment of the JFK Act
4. pertain to communications with the John F. Kennedy Library after the enactment of the JFK regarding the return or disposition of any records to you or your husband.
5. pertain to communications with Attorney General Robert F. Kennedy and Walter Sheridan at any time during 1963 and 1964,
5. relate to Sam Giancana,
6. were created by, sent to, or came into the possession of Walter Sheridan at any time (specify date p\*eriod) that he was an employee of the Federal government that pertain to organized crime or labor racketeering.

#### Definitions

“you” means Mrs. Nancy Sheridan

“and” and “or” are terms of inclusion and not exclusion.

“document” means refer to language in F.R. Civ. P.

JFK Act means the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, 44 U.S.C. § 2107 (Supp. V 1994)
