Pursuant to the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, 44 U.S.C. § 2107, the Assassinations Records Review Board requests that the Department of Justice issue a *subpoena duces tecum* to:

I am enclosing a draft subpoena containing an Attachment A that identifies the types of records that we are seeking as well as the subjects on which we wish to depose Mr. Underwood. We have identified the return date as Friday, August 8, 1997.

It is our understanding that Mr. Underwood was a Federal employee during the Kennedy and Johnson administrations who nominally was under the employ of the Department of Commerce but who, in reality, served as a presidential advance man for both Presidents Kennedy and Johnson.
