This file was artificially created by the Kennedy Library in the early 1970s when national security classified items were segregated from the unclassified items during processing. This division of the Subject File resulted in two separate files: The Subject File, which contained the unclassified material; and the Classified Subject File, which contained the classified material. Later, re-integration of materials was accomplished through Angola (boxes WH-1 - WH-3). The remainder of the files will not be reintegrated but will remain as two separate files.

Researchers who wish to be notified of the opening of folders should complete the Openings Notification Request form available in the Library's Research room or from the Library's Foreign Policy Unit.
