Transcript of portions of the Oliver North Show on 5/29/95

North: I'm a big critic of this administration. You have probably heard me probably as much as anyone, criticize the Clinton Administration. Let me tell you something I think they did was good, that was to convene this Assassination Records Review Board. Because one of the reasons why people create in their minds, and I'm not saying you did Trudy, I'm not saying anybody out there necessarily did. But the uncertainty is out there because there is information blacked out about Lee Harvey Oswald. I like to remind people I was born in Texas, nonetheless I am from Missouri -- show me. I happen to have seen all kinds of examples where people create in their minds and therefore in the minds of others, conspiracy theories.

North: Friends we have been talking about trying to knock down some of the conspiracy theories. One of the ones that keeps coming up and every phone line is lit up all across America here at the Common Sense Radio Network, is the theories behind the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. There is no one I know of yet alive today who was alive then that doesn't remember where they were when that event happened. We now have on the line John Tunheim, Deputy Assistant Attorney General for the state of Minnesota. He is the Chairman of the President's Assassination Records Review Board. Jack you didn't hear me say this because you were busy and weren't on the phone yet, but I said as a critic of this administration one of the things I want to commend Bill Clinton for is his willingness to help end some of these conspiracy theories by opening up the records.
