- Identification of all communications between CLA and Congress regarding JFK Act procedures for handling Congressional materials (especially HSCA).

The Archives sent to the ARRB a copy of the December 21, 1992 letter from Congressman Rose to Director Wilson. Are there any other written communications? Have there been any pertinent oral communications? Has the CLA heard anything from Congress with respect to its preferences for procedures for handling the ARRB review of HSCA materials?

- CLA's current understanding of its role and responsibilities with respect to handling:
 - HSCA materials
 - other Congressional materials (Church, Pike, Abzug, SSCI, HPSCI, etc.)
- CLA's current concerns about relations with Congress and handling materials
- Current status of HSCA materials:
 - referrals (number outstanding)
 - which agencies are most remiss
 - status of review of audio materials
 - current status of referrals that have been returned
(*e.g.*, HSCA staff notes)
- Recommendations from CLA regarding the ARRB's review of HSCA materials:
 - with respect to dealing with Congress generally
 - with respect to particular persons (Members or Staff)
 - with respect to logistics between the CLA and the ARRB
- Is there anything the Review Board can do to assist CLA?
- Any additional thoughts or concerns of the CLA?
