Subject: USSS Priorities

On April 8, 1997, David Marwell finally spoke to Jane Vezeris about a large number of issues that had been piling up during her absence of the last three months. David has not discussed this conversation with me.

David asked me to prepare a summary of our priorities that he could fax to Jane. I presented the enclosed memo dated April 8, 1997.

Meantime, Jeremy interceded. Jeremy had spent several days at the LBJ Library in March but had failed to look at the Secret Service box. Jeremy insisted that the material in this box, which he did not see, is now the highest priority in the Secret Service collection.

My suggestion that we ask the Service to clarify their position on RIFs has more to it. Since the protective surveys contain information that is relevant to larger issues still to come, David's lack of emphasis on the surveys only further delays the resolution of a disagreement over a large group of records.
