Dear Mr. Krill:

I am writing you on behalf of the Assassination Records Review Board, an independent Federal Agency established pursuant to the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act, 44 U.S.C. § 2107 (Supp. V 1994). The Review Board, whose members are appointed by the President and confirmed by the Senate, is charged with the responsibility of collecting records and information related to the assassination of President Kennedy. The Review Board is not seeking to reach any conclusions regarding the assassination, but is primarily concerned with identifying, clarifying, locating, and making available assassination records. I am enclosing some explanatory material about the Review Board and its mandate.

When I spoke with your wife this morning, she indicated that you might be willing to speak with me or another member of the Review Board staff about your work at the Secret Service in the early 1960s and about Secret Service records. At her suggestion, I will call you again sometime at the end of September or the beginning of October. If you would be willing to talk with us sooner than the end of September, please call me. We will be happy to come to your house at a time that is convenient for you.
