- --A recording of a 13-minute interview with Chief James Rowley on August 7, 1963, conducted by Congressman Frank Horton (Rochester, New York). Chief Rowley commented on the changes he found necessary to accommodate the pace of President Kennedy's travels; security arrangements for the President's foreign travel; Rowley's participation in Presidential protection; general problems with Presidential security; and Secret Service agents on the President's limousine.
 - --8 Protective surveys for President Kennedy (October 30, 1963-November 21, 1963)
