Subject: Review Board Decisions Regarding US Secret Service Materials

At the August 5-6, 1996 meeting, the Review Board designated 8 protective surveys for the October 31, 1963-November 21, 1963 period "assassination records." These were planned Presidential trips to the following cities: Philadephia; Elkton, Maryland; New York; Palm Beach; Cape Canaveral; Miami; Tampa; and San Antonio. The Review Board also designated a 13-minute interview (on a tape cassette) with Chief James Rowley on August 7, 1963, an "assassination record."

The Secret Service had sought to postpone protective information and names in five documents:
