Subject: HSCA Documents from January 30-31, 1996 Board Meeting

The most interesting of the three documents is an interview with Secret Service SA Ernest Aragon, who commented on several topics including: CIA-Secret Service liaison in Miami; Aragon's sense that there were weaknesses in Secret Service protection of the President; and internal disagreements in the Miami Secret Service office over the handling of intelligence about the Cuban community. 180-10078-10450

Another document is an interview with Maurice Martineau, Assistant Special Agent in Charge in Chicago in 1963. Martineau described Secret Service procedures, liaison with Chicago police, and contact with an informant. Martineau was not able to recall details of threats to President Kennedy in November, 1963. Attached to this interview are portions of two November, 1963 Secret Service reports. One described a post-assassination investigation of Cuban groups in Chicago that were purchasing guns and ammunition. The other portion detailed the Secret Service investigation of the mail order purchase of the Italian carbine rifle from Klein's Sporting Goods. 180-10118-10068
