Subject: Richard Case Nagell File at the March 13-14, 1997 Review Board Meeting

At the January 29, 1997 meeting, the Assassination Records Review Board examined the Secret Service Richard Case Nagell file and voted to open it (with the exception of two Social Security Numbers).

After the Review Board voted, the Bureau of Prisons (BOP) sent ARRB a letter (dated February 18, 1997) stating objections to the release of BOP documents in the Nagell file. Citing "Section 6" of the JFK Act, the BOP raised privacy concerns pertaining to Nagell's children.

At the March 13-14, 1997 meeting, three members of the Review Board re-examined the BOP documents along with the letter of February 18, 1997. None of the Review Board members wished to take any further action in response to the BOP letter.

The result is that the Review Board will direct the Secret Service to release its Nagell file (with the exception of two Social Security Numbers) to the National Archives by April 10, 1997. The ARRB will also notify the Bureau of Prisons of this release.
