Subject: limousine photos

COMMENTS:

Steve:

I am enclosing two pages from an affidavit by Secret Service SA Charles Taylor dated March 1976, and prepared for the Church Committee. Taylor discussed the search of the limousine after Secret Service agents drove it to the White House garage from Andrews Air Force Base. After 1:00 AM on November 23, 1963, a team of FBI agents searched--and disassembled--the limousine. While the car was disassembled, someone allegedly took photographs of it. I am wondering whether you recall seeing any photographs --possibly in black and white--of the limousine while it was disassembled. This disassembly and reassembly apparently took place before a Secret Service photographer, James Fox, took color pictures at 4 PM on November 23, 1963. I do recall seeing those color photos of the limo in the Secret Service Case File. I have not found any reference to an FBI report on this early morning examination of the limo nor have I seen any photos generated by the FBI. If such pictures are not in the JFK collection, we will ask the FBI to provide them. Do you know of any FBI photos of the limousine?

Eric is coming up to the Archives some time next week. He has a few RIFs from the FBI that mention photos and the limousine (but none of the documents seems very likely). He can follow up on what you find.
