This memorandum does not have a RIF since it does not appear in any of our databases. Chet advises obtaining a RIF from Archives I.

This memorandum, which was prepared by a HSCA researcher in 1978, describes some of the material that was destroyed by the Secret Service in January, 1995. It has high public interest.

In the October 20, 1995 letter, the Secret Service listed both 6(3) and 6(5) postponements for this document.

Page 1: All of the individuals bracketed should be released. At 32 and 39 on our grid, there appear to be 6(5) postponements. The Board may wish to consider justifications offered by the Secret Service for these postponements.

Page 2: All of the individuals bracketed should be released. At 13 and 36 on our grid, there appear to be 6(5) postponements. The Board may wish to consider justifications offered by the Secret Service for these postponements.

Page 3: All of the individuals and the file number bracketed should be released. The Board may wish to consider justifications offered by the Secret Service for the file number (at 2 on our grid).

Page 4: All of the individuals bracketed should be released. At 18, 17, and 20 on our grid there seem to be 6(5) postponements. The Board may wish to consider justifications offered by the Secret Service for these postponements. Compare the 6(5) postponements with the Report for Cheyenne, WY.

Attached to this report are Secret Service Report Forms. Most of the bracketed information on these forms consists of names and addresses. All of this should be released. An exception follows:
