Subject: Potential Request to USSS for Additional Material: Abraham Bolden and Chicago Cubans

- 1. Bolden's supervisor was Harvey Henderson when Bolden was on the White House detail. Bolden complained to him about laxity. Where are letters/complaints?
- 2. James Rowley was contacted by Bolden, who complained about behavior of agents on the White House detail. Any documentation of this?
- 3. Bolden described the interrogation of suspects (November 1, 1996) who had reportedly threatened President Kennedy. One had a Cuban sounding name. Ask for all COS material datedOctober 15-December 31, 1963, coming from the Chicago office. Possibly sent by Maurice Martineau, Noonan, Strong, Edward Tucker.
- 4. Notebooks and/or memos based on these notebooks on surveillance conducted in Chicago in November, 1963. Sent by Martineau to Washington.
- 5. Bolden said his notebook in which he recorded events of October 30-November 2, 1963, was taken from him by Secret Service agents in 1964. We could ask for this.
